We grow & produce our award winning Pebblebed Wines right here on the farm, with the vineyard & winery just over the hedge from our grazing Ruby Reds & vegetables. The Farm Table is also home to Sandford Orchard's Small Batch Cidery, where Barny Butterfield & his team craft unique & innovative ciders.

Beyond our farm, we work to build long term relationships with small artisan producers who share our values, from Devon to the Douro Valley, Topsham to Tuscany. We believe that whatever you are drinking, the people whose life's work has gone into producing it and the people that you are sharing it with, are as important as what is in the bottle!

A note on pricing...

Rather than applying conventional restaurant margins to wine, we simply place a fixed cash margin on bottles from our cellar, similar to corkage. This essentially means the better the wine, the better the value!

Sparkling Wine

PEBBLEBED VINEYARDS

Darts Farm, Clyst St George, England

Pebblebed began with our dear late friend & neighbour, Geoff Bowen, in 1999. Geoff saw a bright future for English wine, and had a vision for a sustainable vineyard at the heart of the local community, producing wines people could call their own. We are proud to be building on Geoff's legacy, with longstanding winemaker Alex Mills continuing to craft award winning wines right here on the farm. Our sparkling wines are made in the traditional 'champagne' method, with bottle fermentation & a minimum of two years on the lees.

Sparkling White, 2018 - Seyval Blanc | 7.5 / 35

Crisp green apple aromas with lime, citrus notes and a buttery brioche finish.

Sparkling Rosé, 2018 - Seyval Blanc, Rondo | 7.5 / 35

Red berry & rose petals are balanced with fresh acidity .

DOMAINE VINCENT BOUZEREAU

Meursault, Burgundy, France

We met Vincent & his family back in 2014 and have been out to visit nearly every year since, with 5 of Vincent's 6 children coming over to work with us at here Darts Farm. Vincent owns around 10 hectares of vines across the Cote de Beaune, ranging from village appellations to grand cru. Vincent & his son Louis take a natural approach to winemaking, passed down through 6 generations. Their Crémant De Bourgogne is made in the traditional 'champagne' method.

Crémant de Bourgogne, NV - Chardonnay, Aligote, Pinot Noir | 35

Delicate sparkling with pure & light bouquet, notes of green apple, citrus & honey.

GREMILLET

Balnot sur Laignes, Champagne, France

The Gremillet estate was founded by Jean-Michel Gremillet in 1979 when he inherited a plot of vines from his mother, Lulu. Today, the house possesses over 40 hectares of vineyards and is situated in a small village 45 kilometres from Troyes - the historic capital of Champagne - and 180 kilometres south of Reims. The vines lie on steep, sun-drenched hillsides in Kimmeridgian clay-limestone soils. Pinot Noir is king here, and constitutes around 94% of Gremillet's plantings, with the remainder dedicated to Chardonnay, ideal for creating a classic, baked biscuit, rich, fruit-flavoured Champagne.

Brut Reserve, Champagne, France, NV - Pinot Noir, Chardonnay | 47 / 99

Fresh floral aromas combine with characteristic sweet brioche overtones, balanced by peach skin and baked biscuit flavours with a crisp citrus finish.

VAUVERSIN

Oger, Champagne, France

Something truly special. Laurent is the 4th generation to produce champagne on his families small 3 hectare organic estate, in the village of Oger. All of Laurent's vineyard's are Grand Cru, the top classification of champagne, which is extremely rare and hardly talked about by the famous houses, simply because they don't own enough Grand Cru vineyards. Only 18,000 bottles a year, we believe Laurent's champagne is some of the best in the world.

Original Blanc de Blancs Grand Cru, NV - Chardonnay | 54 / 109

On the nose, pear & green apple followed by classic dry characteristic with a creamy texture and notes of tart green fruits.

Opair Grand Cru, NV - Chardonnay | 64

A nose of honeycomb & brioche followed by ripe orchard fruits & crisp citrus
